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1. General

- IB offers four programmes – where one is the Diploma Programme, DP.
- DP is implemented and taught by IB World Schools.
- IB establish the assessments requirements and procedures.



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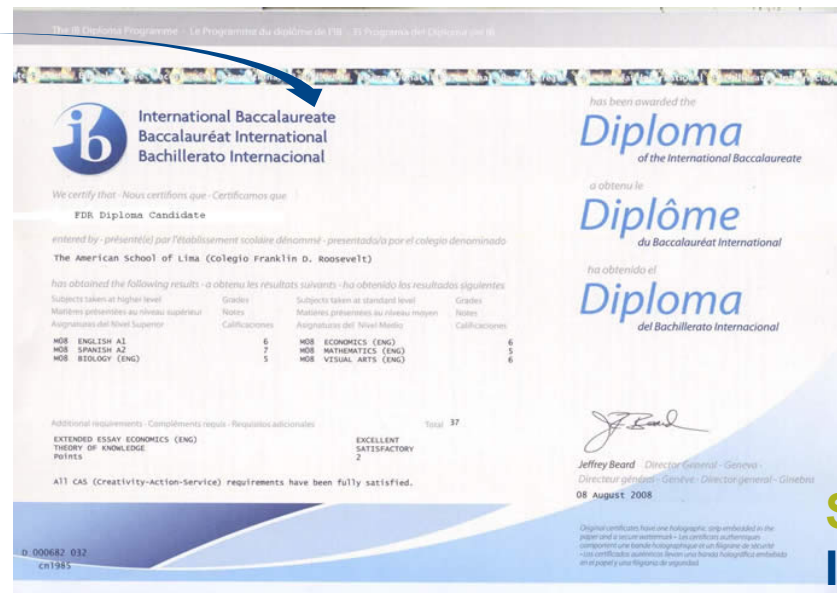


GENERAL REGULATIONS

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1. General

- To qualify to award the IB Diploma a candidate must follow the course of study.
- Six subjects and the core.
- The core: Extended Essay, Creativity, Action and Service and Theory of Knowledge.



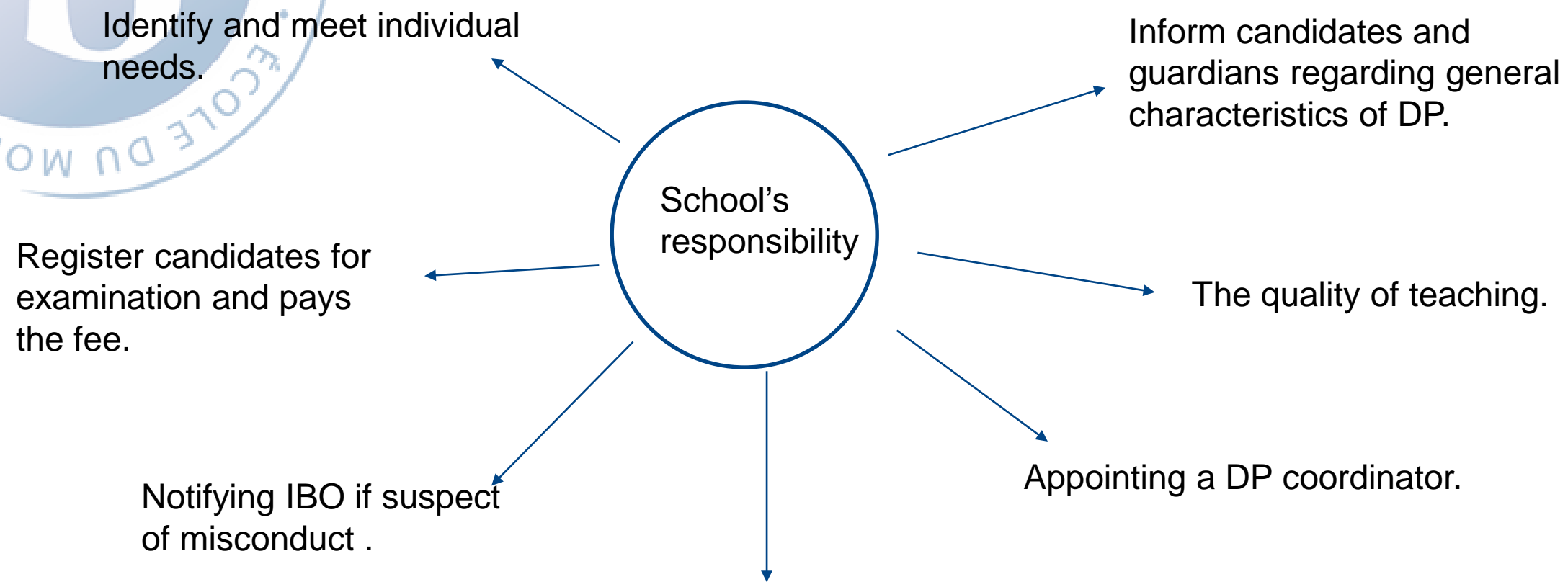
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GENERAL REGULATIONS

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1. General



Identify and meet individual needs.

Inform candidates and guardians regarding general characteristics of DP.

The quality of teaching.

Appointing a DP coordinator.

Ensure candidates comply with all assessment requirements.

Notifying IBO if suspect of misconduct .

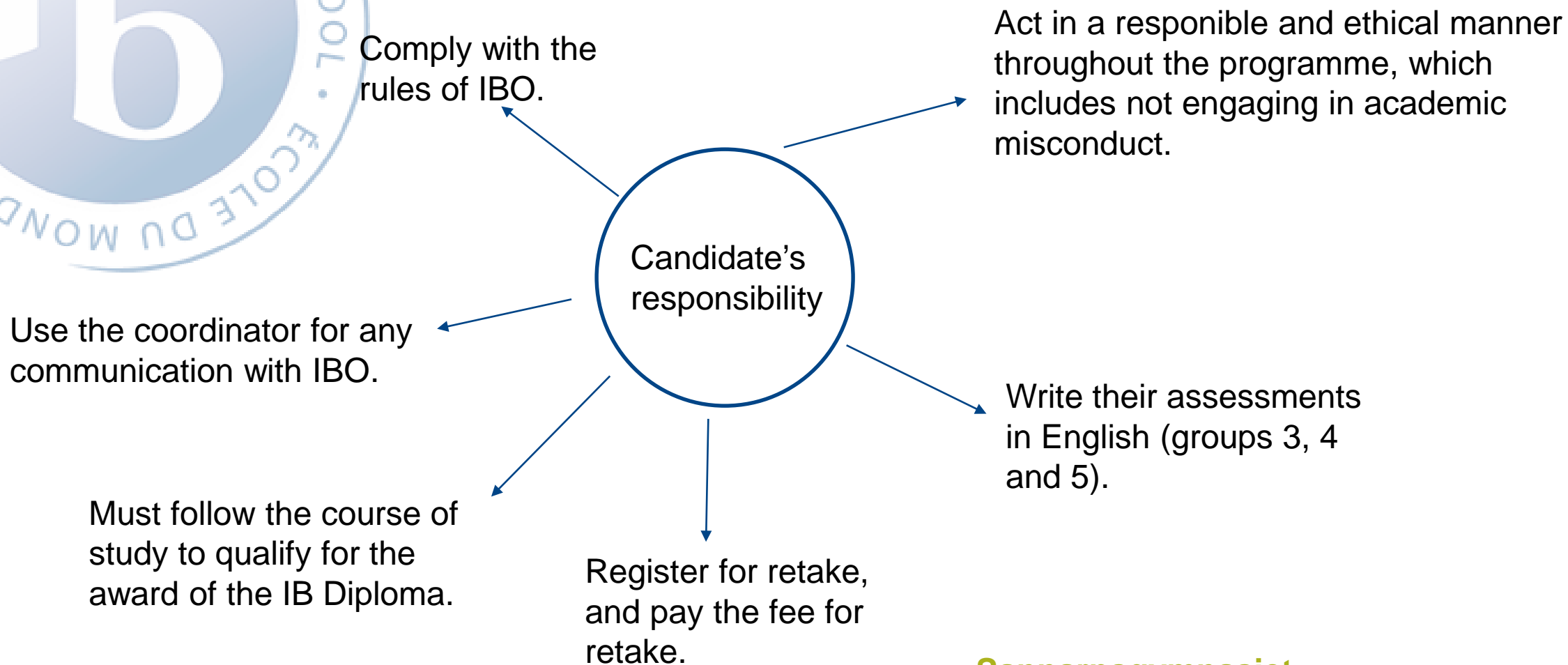
Register candidates for examination and pays the fee.

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2. The Diploma Programme

CONTENT – The Diploma Programme

- Six subject – Three Higher Level (HL) and three Standard Level (SL) – selected from different groups.

- The Core -
 - EE – Extended essay
 - TOK – Essay and presentation.
 - CAS – Creativity, Activity and Service.



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2. The Diploma Programme

COURSE CANDIDATES

- Candidates who for whatever reason choose not to take the entire DP are referred to as *Course Candidates*.
- Course Candidates receive certificates.





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3. Assessment

REGISTRATION

- ④ Registration is conducted by the coordinator for Diploma candidates and for Course candidates.

- ④ Retake is for previous candidates who are seeking to improve their results.
 - The fee for retake is paid by the candidate.
 - Retake can be done no more than two times.
 - At Sannarp retake can be done in May only.



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3. Assessment

GRADES

- 📘 Performance in each subject is graded 1 to 7.
- 📘 CAS is not graded, but compulsory.
- 📘 Performance in EE and TOK are graded E to A.
- 📘 Maximum points are 45.

AWARD OF THE DIPLOMA

- CAS requirements are met.
- At least 24 points.
- No "N". (Withdrawn, failed to submit work or are guilty of misconduct).
- No E in TOK and/or EE.
- No grade 1.
- No more than two grade 2s.
- No more than three grade 3s.
- Gained 12 points or more in HL subjects.
- Gained 9 points or more in SL subjects.
- Has not received penalty for academic misconduct.

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3. Enquiry of results

REMARKING

- Candidates may ask for a remarking of a subject.
- This is done at the expense of the candidate (2017: registration fee: 122 Euro, per subject: 85 Euro)
- This may lead to a higher or lower result.





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4. Special cases

Candidates affected by adverse circumstances.

- Defined as those beyond the control of the candidate.
- An application* for special consideration in cases of adverse circumstances must be submitted by the coordinator and be supported by evidence.



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4. Special cases

ACADEMIC MISCONDUCT

- ❶ Behaviour that results in, or may result in, any candidate gaining an unfair advantage, eg plagiarism, collusion, duplication or misconduct during exam will lead to an investigation by IBO.
- ❷ In case of academic misconduct a penalty will be applied.
- ❸ IBO can refuse to mark or moderate assessments if a candidate has acted irresponsible.
- ❹ IBO may decide to not issue a grade and additionally prohibit the candidate from being registered in any future examination sessions.



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SHORT SUMMARY

- IBO sets the rules – school and candidates have to comply.
- To award a Diploma candidates must follow the study courses and meet the requirements in points, CAS, TOK and EE.
- Registration for one examination session is paid by Sannarpsgymnasiet. Any retake is paid by the candidates.
- Retake may be done two times.
- If there are any special cases an application must be sent to IBO before examination.
